

Fund Overview

- Objective: to provide income exceeding 110% of the dividend income of the MSCI All Cap index and an overall return (income plus capital growth) which is superior to that index. At least 80% of the fund will be invested in the shares of UK companies.
- The portfolio has a bias towards small and medium sized companies and a high active share compared to the benchmark.
- The fund has significant capacity and liquidity.
- The investment philosophy is value-based, combining high yield and superior dividend growth strategies.
- A concentrated portfolio of 25-35 holdings, with a focus on high and growing dividend income.



Monthly Commentary

Market Background

The UK market has retreated somewhat from its recent bounce despite superior EPS trends which seem to have done little to support UK equities in the year to date. However, some forecasts from analysts have moderated a little as they attempt to factor in the implications of rising supply and other input costs and the consequent implications for margins. Stock market leadership was pretty narrow during the month focussing mostly on energy and bank stocks and retail investor sentiment is now as bearish as in October 2020. Concerns over energy prices, stagflation, Chinese growth and central bank tapering persist.

Performance

The fund posted a poor performance in October being markedly underweight in banks and energy. In addition, the small to mid cap part of the market took a significant beating as the market focussed on the cost and macro pressures mentioned above. Although we have given up a few months of outperformance we remain positive on the outlook for the remainder of this calendar year and would not be surprised if the small and mid cap segments of the market were to stage a comeback. We are happy with the value tilt of the portfolio given inflation risks.

Portfolio Activity

There was a reasonable amount of activity in some of our holdings through October. We exited our position in Abrdn as we felt it to be more fairly valued and we continued the rationalisation of our disappointing property holdings with the exit of our position in Newriver REIT and reduced our holding in Palace Capital. We also trimmed positions in Tate & Lyle and Lloyds Banking. We initiated a position in Wincanton, the provider of logistics and supply solutions. In addition, we invested in Brickability, a supplier of facing bricks and related materials.
